Innovation & Integration: What's new for Individuals, Families, Providers, & Communities?

Description: *FOR-NY integrates the recovery community through fostering collaboration and support among individuals in recovery, their families, and professional allies. These partnerships are creating new initiatives and reshaping the landscape of community-based addiction prevention, treatment, and recovery support services in New York State.*
